

Current Information about roadblocks

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

Around 1.5 metres of fresh snow has fallen on the mountains. Mountain and bike tours are therefore not possible in the near future. Please note the considerable risk of avalanches!

<u>Hikes</u>

Promenade from Pension Waldruhe to Fischersteg

Due to a mudslide, the promenade is closed until further notice.

Waldsteig/Salza-Stausee:

The circular route is currently only partially open until further notice due to work on the forest road: the route along the Salza reservoir up to the hill is accessible. Return to the starting point using the same route.

Hiking trail Schwarzensee - Leistalm

The hiking trail is closed until further notice due to fallen trees caused by snow pressure.

From the Tauplitzalm to the Gnanitzalm

Due to a storm, the bridge over the Grimmingbach was damaged. For information about the danger spot between the Interhüttenalm and the Gnanitzalm, please contact the market town of Stainach-Pürgg on 03682/24800.

Bike, MTB and e-bike routes

Rambichlstraße Altaussee

Due to a landslide, Rambichlstraße in Altaussee is closed until Friday, 04 October 2024. The slope stabilisation work has already begun. This closure affects the following bike tours:

- S126 Via Salis e-bike tour
- S440 Sarstein Tour
- S720 6 Lakes Tour
- S800 BergeSeen eTrail
- S840 Dachstein Tour

Narzissen – Leisling round

Due to a severe storm, the section between Pötschenhöhe and Sommersbergsee is closed. A diversion around the closure is only possible along the Salzkammergut federal road B145.

Grabenbach | diversions route between Blaa Alm and Rettenbach Alm

The forest road is closed until further notice due to mudslides between Rettenbachtal and the turn-off towards Hoisnrad.

This means that there is currently no direct connection between Altaussee and Bad Ischl.

Permanent locks

From Gößl to Grundlsee along the Ressenweg trail

Contrary to press reports, the Ressenweg trail between Gößl and Grundlsee is still NOT open for cyclists.

Blaa Alm Altaussee across Rettenbach Valley to Bad Ischl

The path between Blaa Alm and Rettenbachalm is closed to hikers and cyclists due to current danger of rockfall.

A detour is currently possible via Lupitsch / Waldgraben through the Leisling to Bad Goisern.

Tauplitz waterfall across Draxlmühle

The hiking trail to the waterfall across the Draxlmühle is temporarily closed

Salza Reservoir

The Pass Stein road along the Salza reservoir has been closed to hikers and cyclists for years. This closure remains in place until further notice.

Sillstraße

There is a general ban for cyclists since 2020.
