Altaussee Salzwelten (Salt Mine)



The Altaussee Salt Mine, the largest active salt mine in Austria, takes visitors into a fascinating world of centuries-old mining history and exciting events surrounding stolen Nazi looted art. In the deep tunnels and the mystical chapel, courageous miners saved valuable European works of art from destruction during the Second World War - a piece of contemporary history that comes to life

A special highlight for families are the lovingly designed children's tours with Sally, the clever miner duck, who playfully introduces young visitors to life underground and is sure to delight young and old alike.

Parish church Grundlsee



Due to its recent development into a popular tourist destination, the need for its own place of worship grew in the community. The foundation stone of the youngest parish in Ausseerland was laid in 1888, and just one year later the chapel was solemnly consecrated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. As the parish continued to grow, so did church life. Finally, in 1950, a separate pastoral office and an independent parish were established. This was complemented by the establishment of its own cemetery.
